Lessons

1. From what age can you start?

From 4 years old.

2. Are the lessons group or individual?

Individuals. Fine motor skills and posture correction require personalized attention.

3. Where are the lessons held?

In Pantzergasse 8, district 19 of Vienna. Public transport nearby: Metro U6 (Nussdorferstraße), Metro U4 (Spittelau), trams 37 and 38 (Glatzgasse stop), bus 35A (Liechtenwerder Platz stop).

4. Can I attend my child's lessons?

For concentration reasons, parents, siblings, or friends are not allowed in the trial or regular classes. There is a comfortable waiting room, and before the lesson, you can see the space and talk with me to ensure your child feels at ease.

5. How often are the lessons?

Once a week, 50 minutes. A fixed day is assigned according to the teacher's availability.

6. Can I attend lessons less frequently?

No. Continuity is essential: with fewer lessons, the student would not know how to organize their practice. The biweekly format is only recommended for professional violinists with experience in managing their own practice independently.

7. Are lessons given on holidays or during school breaks?

No lessons on days when children don't have school. However, if requested and the teacher is available, extra lessons can be scheduled.

8. In which language are the lessons held?

Mainly in German, but also available in Spanish, English, or Italian at no extra cost.

9. Will there be homework to do at home?

Yes. Home practice is recommended to reinforce learning. Parents are advised to help establish a routine.

10. I am an adult, can I start learning the violin?

Of course! Lessons are adapted to the rhythm and goals of adults. You must bring your own violin from the beginning.

11. I don't have a violin, what should I do?

The violin is included in the trial lesson (up to 13 years old). If you continue, you can rent one for €30 per month. As the student grows, the instrument is replaced at no extra cost.

12. What violin size do I need?

It depends on age and height. The following sizes are only a guideline; it's best to confirm with us or a luthier.

4 - 6	1/8
6 -7	1/4
7 - 8	1/2
8 - 11	3/4
from 12	4/4

13. What happens if a string or the rosin breaks?

Violin maintenance is the responsibility of the student. You can replace it yourself (we will advise you on which one to buy) or, if you prefer, we can replace it for a cost of €10 per item. If the Violin, bow or case breaks a fixed penalty of €200 will be applied, regardless of whether the repair costs more.

Payment

14. I cannot attend a paid lesson, what should I do?

If you inform us of your absence at least 24 hours in advance, the lesson can be rescheduled within the current or following month, depending on the teacher's availability, on a date additional to your regular weekly lesson. Cancellations made with less than 24 hours' notice cannot be refunded or rescheduled.

15. How and when are payments made?

In advance, before the start of the month, by transfer or cash. -Payment must be made before the 30th. A penalty of €1 per day of delay applies, payable with the next month.

16. What if I don't want to continue lessons anymore?

You must notify before the start of the next month to end the registration without complications.

17. What are the costs of the lessons?

Trial lesson: 20€ (30 minutes).

Annual registration: 100€ (reservation of the spot).
